	<p>The department discussed the option of revising the Math 52 curriculum to be a 5 unit class that includes exponents and polynomials and introducing a co-requisite course for students who place below Math 52 as well as an alternative pathway to statistics.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> It was agreed that the department should move forward on this in collaboration with WCC. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> E. Noffsinger and K. Stemmann will work on the COR for the new Math 52 and the co-requisite course There was some discussion on the best format of the co-requisite (1 unit vs. 2 units, lab/lecture, 1st 8 weeks vs. whole semester). The dept. decided to try a 2 unit (1 unit lab/1 unit lecture) course that meets the full semester, the first part dedicated to the prerequisite material and the second part dedicated to just-in-time remediation. S. Kovaks asked about how this will impact online classes. It was generally agreed that the co-requisite class would probably not be a good candidate for an online class. J. Steverson and Sharma will work on the curriculum for the alternative pathway. It was recommended that they start by looking at the current Math 58 curriculum. The department will try to implement the changes FA18.
