2018.9.7.01	Sonya Horn brought the concern about Math 52 and 52B being the same in the system causing issues with repeatability of the course.	Team	The whole team agreed that Math 52, 52A and 52B are different courses. Math 52B≠Math 52 but 52A+52B=Math 52. Same follows for Math 101.
